WHAT'S NEW



PARKING

KIMBARK SOUTH PARKING

A new parking garage, located at 6021 South Kimbark Avenue is now open. Parking permit and visitor options are available in the new, gated, covered facility. The facility includes a staffed parking office on the first floor, for permit purchases and inquiries.

DAILY PARKING OPTION

Parking Services is now offering daily parking options, available through payroll deduction, in the Campus North Garage. Preferred days will need to be pre-selected, in order to program access. The options are:

- One day per week at a monthly rate of \$28
- Two days per week at a monthly rate of \$56
- Three days per week at a monthly rate of \$84

TRANSPORTATION

DOWNTOWN CAMPUS CONNECTOR ROUTE

The University is continuing to offer a new route, Monday–Friday, 6:30 a.m. until 10 p.m., providing service from points on campus and Hyde Park to the Gleacher Center, UCMC downtown clinics, Union and Ogilvie Stations and the Roosevelt Station in South Loop.

LYFT RIDE SMART AT UCHICAGO

Lyft Ride Smart at UChicago offers students 7 free rides per month (up to \$10 off per ride) on all late-night rides within the service area during program hours (7 evenings; 5 p.m.–4 a.m.). This program is available to all students. To sign up, students will need to opt-in to the program via the email invitation from Lyft. Once a student joins the program, their monthly free rides will be available in their Lyft app and will automatically apply to rides which meet the program eligibility criteria.

METRA BENEFIT

A complimentary Metra 10-ride pass is offered to all students, beginning in Autumn Quarter. All students are eligible to request the 10-ride pass beginning September 26, 2023. Sign-up for the pass is available via myuchicago. The 10-ride pass is available until January 31, 2024, and the expiration on the 10-ride pass is 90 days. The pass provides service on Metra Electric, all zones. Students must have a Ventra account to request the pass.

Ticketed parkers have 60 days to pay their fine or a \$20 late fee will be imposed. Citations cannot be contested after 14 days from the issuing date. Payments can be made online or in the Transportation & Parking Office. Citations that go to collections must be paid

Benefits-eligible employees can pay for their monthly parking expenses using payroll deduction if parking on campus. Benefits-eligible employees may also pay for their commuting expenses through pre-tax benefits covered by the University. Parking expenses can also be covered if you park in a facility away from your work location.

MOBILE PAYMENT PARKING

Visitors coming to campus will have the option to use a mobile payment application to pay for their parking. Passport allows drivers to pay for parking using their smartphones or by calling a phone number relevant to the parking location. Passport can be used for visitor parking in the following locations: Chapin, Young, Dorchester, McGiffert, Law, Wells, and along Greenwood Avenue.

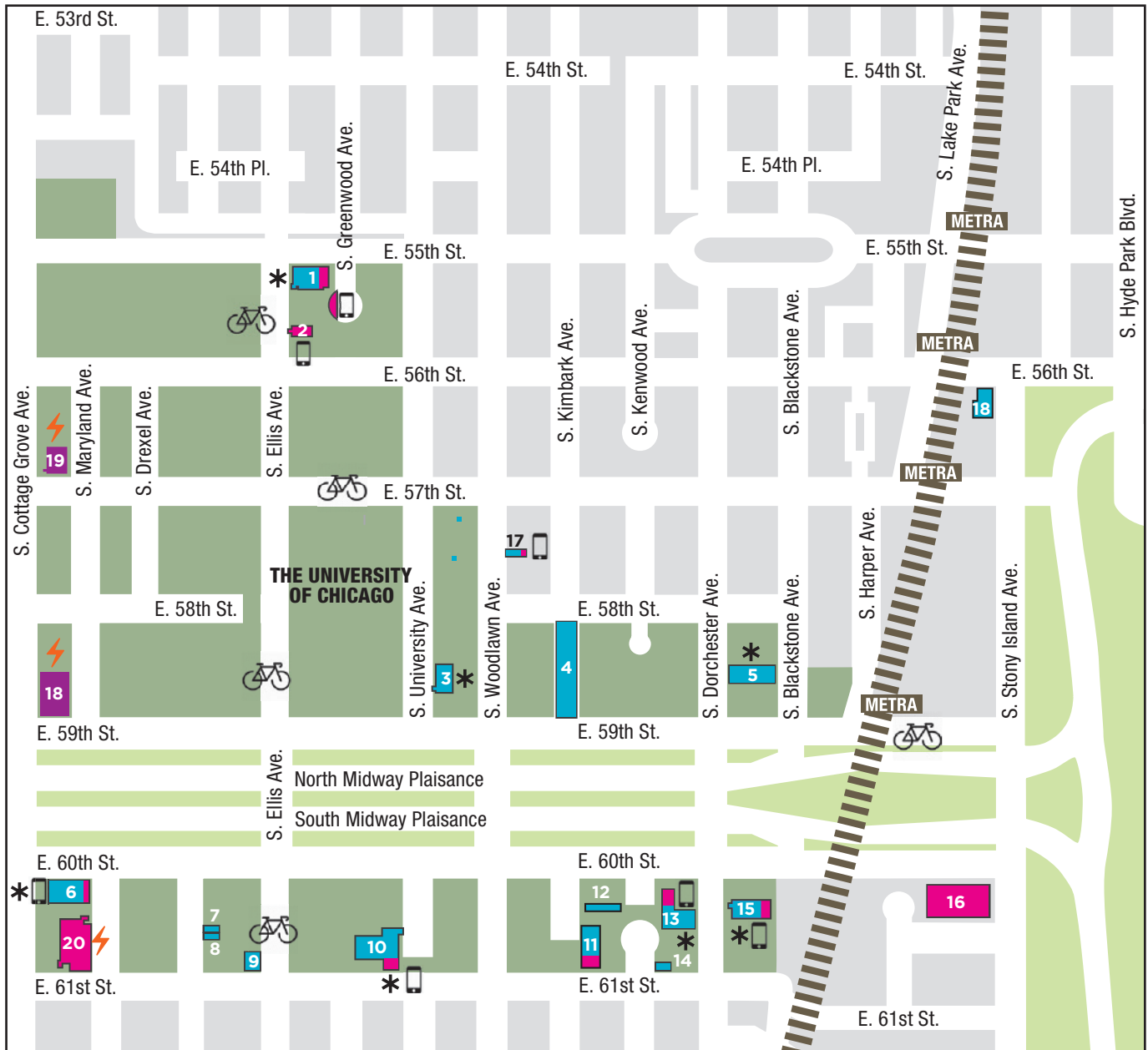
ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM

In support of campus sustainability efforts and to reduce the number of single occupancy vehicles on campus, the University offers an alternative transportation program. Enrollment in the qualifying commuter benefits program allows UChicago members to enroll in the Occasional Parking Program and receive a limited quantity of parking passes for access to Campus North (Ellis) Garage. Participants must qualify annually for this program.

UGO TRANSPORTATION



All University of Chicago shuttles are part of the UGo shuttle program. The UGo shuttles travel around campus and into the neighboring communities. The shuttles are free and run year-round, except on University-observed holidays.

To ride the shuttles, passengers should tap a valid UChicago-issued ID, University of Chicago Medicine ID, Laboratory Schools or Charter Schools ID.

To track any of the UGo shuttles, as well as CTA buses that operate on or near campus, use TransLoc. TransLoc can be viewed as a smartphone app or on monitors in several buildings on campus. TransLoc also provides any temporary reroute or any other service-related information.

UGO DAYTIME SHUTTLES



The University of Chicago provides free daytime shuttle service around campus and into the neighboring communities to all students, faculty, staff, University of Chicago Medicine staff, and University of Chicago Laboratory and Charter School students, faculty, and staff.

The shuttles run year-round except on University-observed holidays. Shuttles stop only at designated locations and do not pick up or drop off passengers at intersections. To ride the shuttles, passengers should tap a valid UChicago-issued ID or University of Chicago Medicine ID when boarding. For more information, visit the Transportation & Parking Services website at transportation.uchicago.edu.

DOWNTOWN CAMPUS CONNECTOR ROUTE *(Monday–Friday, 6:30 a.m.–10 p.m.)*

Provides service to and from the Hyde Park Campus, with downtown stops in South Loop, the Loop, Gleacher Center, UCMC Clinics, and Ogilvie/Union stations. The shuttle service operates every 20 minutes, with 15-minute timepoints at Rockefeller Chapel and Gleacher Center stops.

RED LINE/ARTS BLOCK ROUTE *(Monday–Friday, 6:30 a.m.–9 p.m.)*

Provides service from campus stops at Logan Arts, Levi Hall and the Campus North (Ellis) Garage, to the Garfield Red Line Station, and the Arts Block. The shuttle operates every 10-20 minutes, during the service hours.

FRIEND CENTER AND METRA ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 5 a.m.–9 p.m.)

Departs 59th Street and Drexel Avenue: 0:00 and 0:30; Friend Center: 0:10 and 0:40; 57th Street Metra Station: 0:20 and 0:50.

DREXEL ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 5 a.m.–10 a.m.; use Apostolic/Drexel Route after 10 a.m.)

Departs 61st Street and Drexel Avenue on the tens (0:00, 0:10, 0:20, etc.)

APOSTOLIC ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 5 a.m.–10 a.m.; use Apostolic/Drexel Route after 10 a.m.)

Departs 63rd Street and Kenwood Avenue on the tens (0:00, 0:10, 0:20, etc.).

APOSTOLIC/DREXEL ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 10 a.m.–12:30 a.m.; picks up at both Drexel and Apostolic parking lots)

Scheduled departures from 59th Street & Drexel Avenue: 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.: 0:00, 0:15, 0:30, 0:45

3 p.m. to 6 p.m.: 0:00, 0:10, 0:20, 0:30, 0:40, 0:50

MIDWAY METRA ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 5:40 a.m.–9:40 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.–6:40 p.m.)

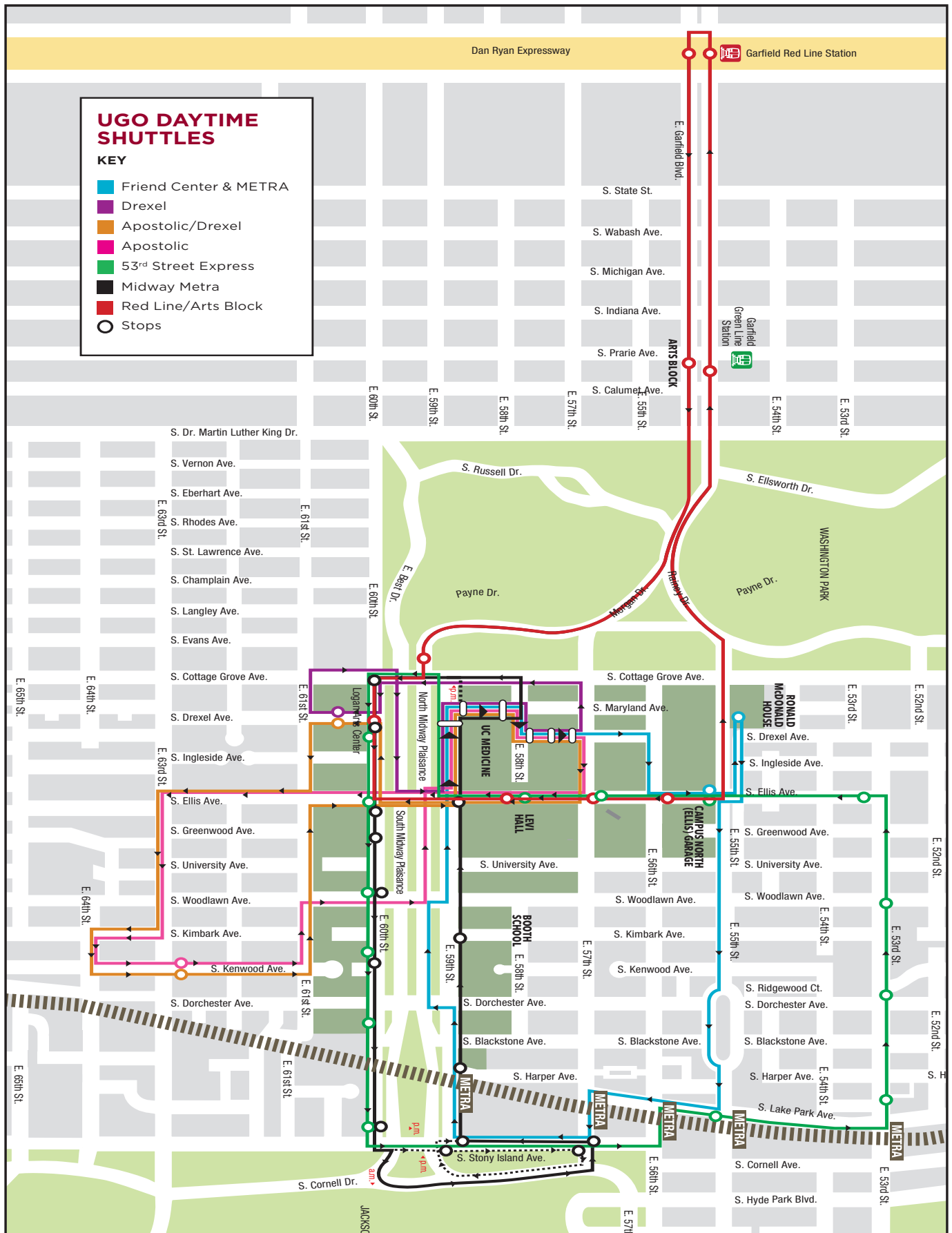
The Midway Metra Shuttle connects the Metra stations at 57th Street and 59th Street with points along 59th and 60th streets, and the University of Chicago Medicine campus.

53rd STREET EXPRESS ROUTE

(Monday–Friday, 7 a.m.–6 p.m.)

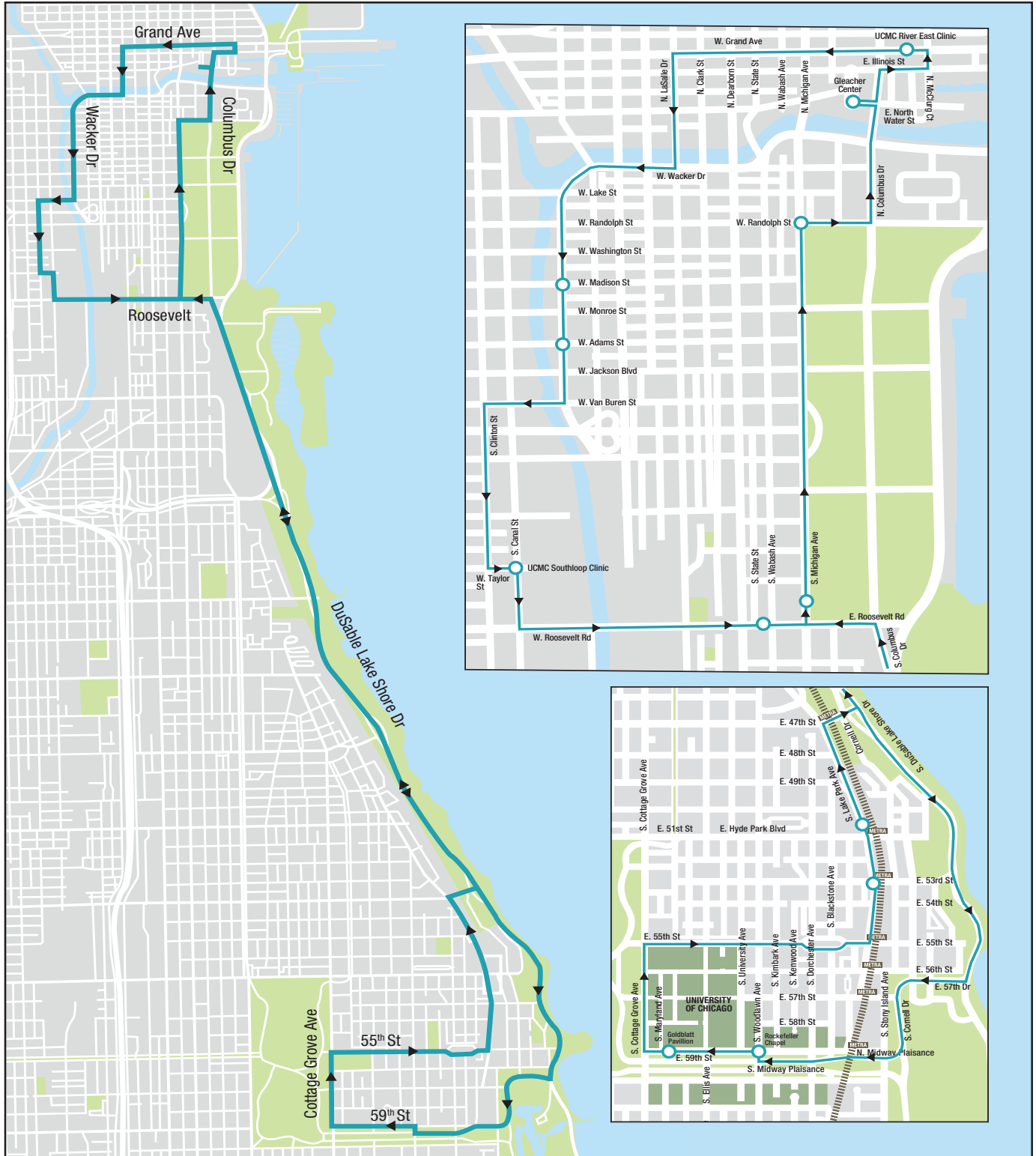
The 53rd Street Express shuttle starts at the Harper Court building, arriving and departing every 30 minutes. The shuttle also stops at 53rd/Kenwood, 53rd/Woodlawn, 53rd/Ellis, Ratner Athletics Center, Levi Hall/Bookstore, Goldblatt Pavilion, Logan Arts Center, 60th/Ellis, 60th/Woodlawn, Press Building, Community lot at 60th/Stony Island, 57th/Stony Island, and 55th/Lake Park. The East Route and Central Route shuttles travels on 53rd Street after the daytime shuttle service ends.

UGO DAYTIME SHUTTLES DOWNTOWN CAMPUS CONNECTOR ROUTE

Monday – Friday, 6:30 a.m. until 10 p.m., providing service to and from the Hyde Park Campus, with downtown stops in South Loop, the Loop, Gleacher Center, UCMC Clinics, and Ogilvie/Union stations. The shuttle service operates every 20 minutes, with 15-minute timepoints at Rockefeller Chapel and Gleacher Center stops.



UGO DAYTIME SHUTTLES

RED LINE/ARTS BLOCK ROUTE

The Redline/Arts Block Shuttle runs Monday-Friday, 6:30 a.m. until 9 p.m., providing service from campus stops at Logan Arts, Levi Hall and the Campus North (Ellis) Garage, to the Garfield Red Line Station, and the Arts Block. The shuttle operates every 10-20 minutes, during the service hours.



UGO NIGHTRIDE SHUTTLES

The NightRide shuttles are free to all University students, faculty, staff, University of Chicago Medicine staff, and Laboratory and Charter School faculty, staff and students. To ride the shuttles, all passengers should tap a valid UChicago ID, University of Chicago Medicine ID, Laboratory Schools ID, or Charter School ID when boarding. Please visit the ID & Privileges website at ipo.uchicago.edu for a list of valid IDs.

HOURS

NightRide operates seven nights a week with reduced service for holidays and Summer Quarter. The routes operate from 4 p.m. to 4 a.m., every evening. The shuttles run approximately every 15 minutes from 4 p.m. to 11 p.m., and approximately every 30 minutes from 11 p.m. until the end of service.

STOPS

For your safety and the safety of all passengers, flag stops can only occur at intersections. To flag a shuttle between designated stops, customers should safely stand at the intersection to allow the shuttle to safely pull over. Remember, NightRide operates when it is dark outside, so it is important to be visible to the driver and indicate to him or her that you would like to board. To indicate a stop while on the shuttle, pull the cord or ask the driver. The driver will then stop at the next safe intersection.

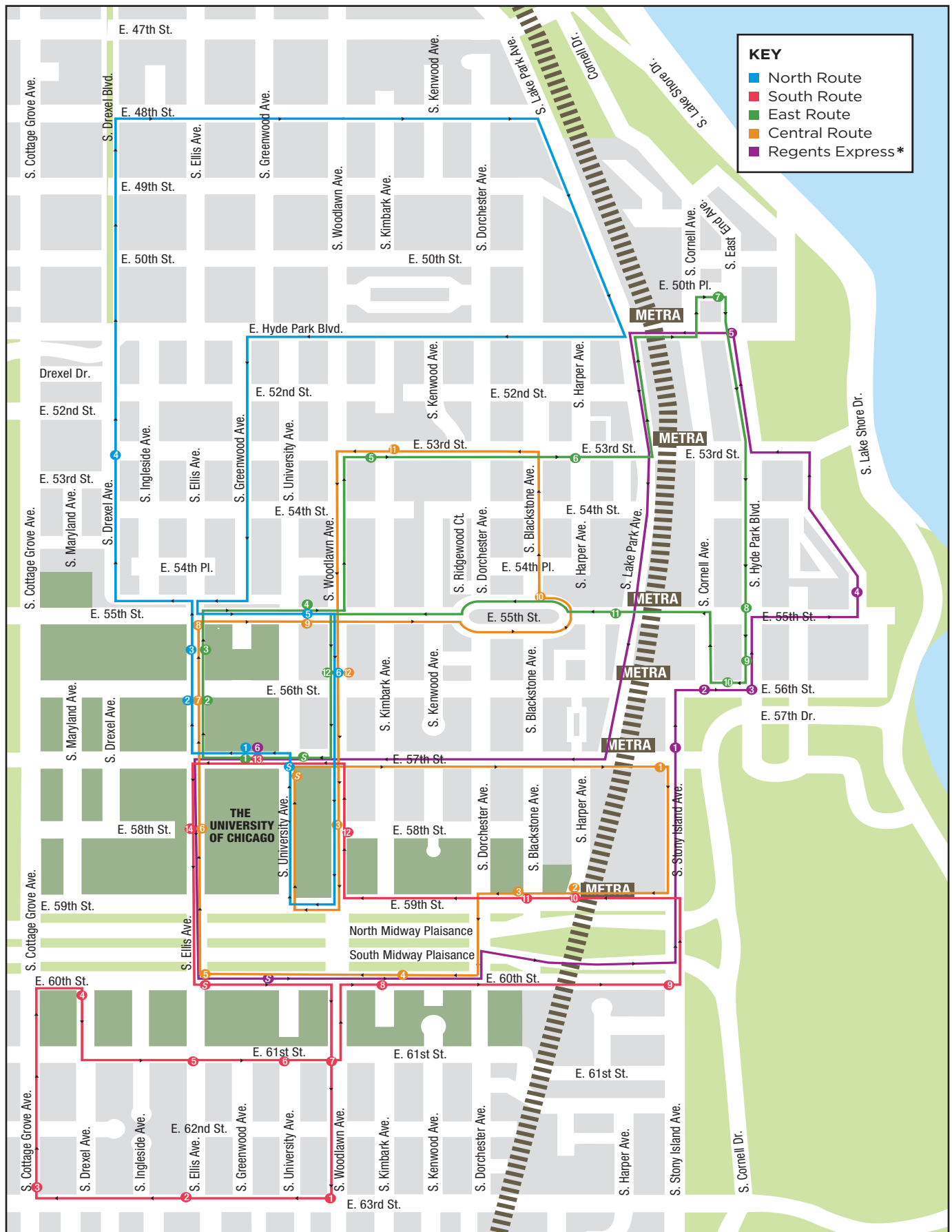

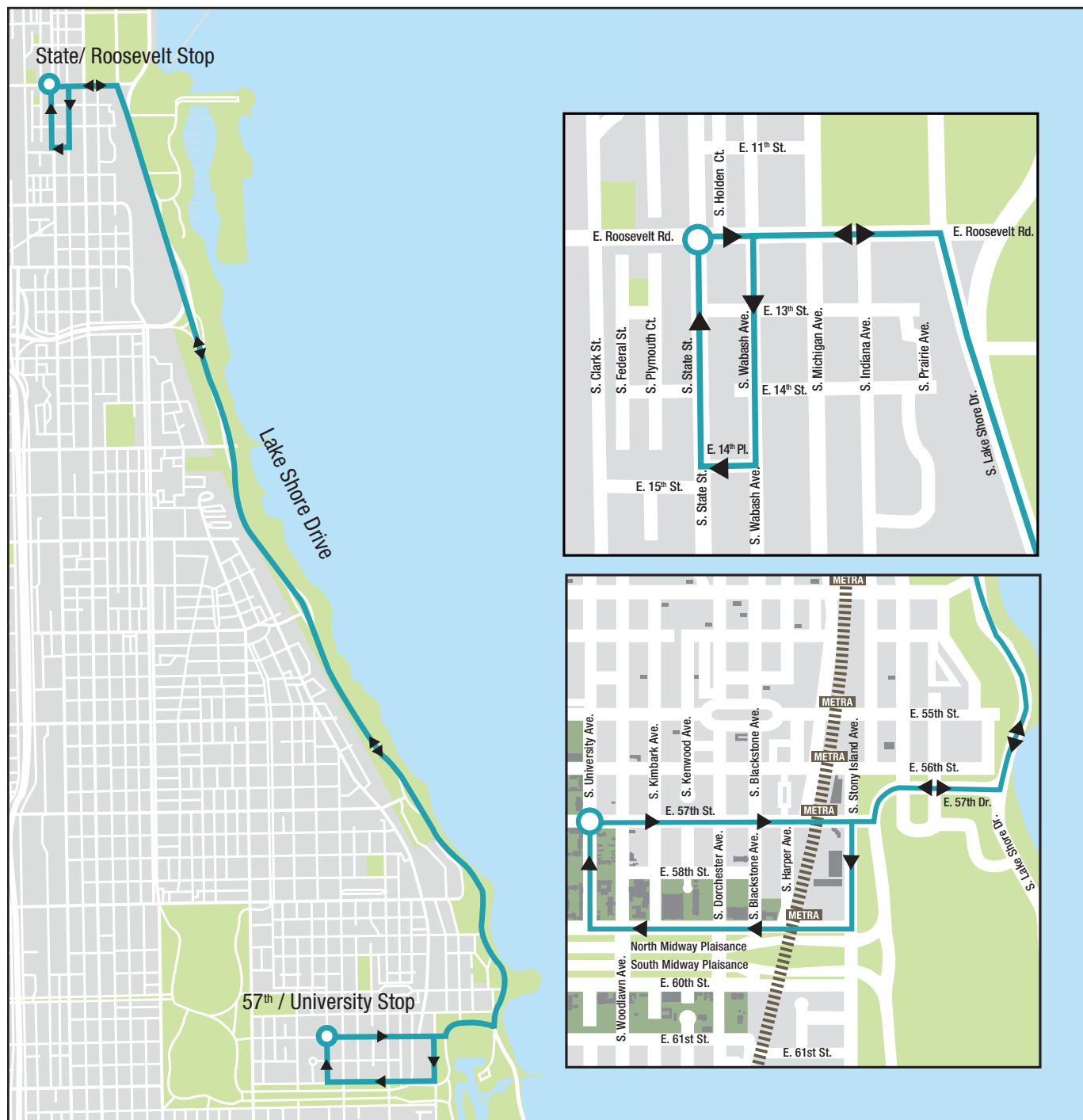

UGO NIGHTRIDE SHUTTLES SOUTH LOOP ROUTE

The South Loop Shuttle operates between campus and Chicago's South Loop neighborhood on Friday and Saturday nights from 6 p.m. until 12:30 a.m. The South Loop Shuttle only stops at designated stops and does not pick up or drop off passengers at intersections. This service is free and available for University students, faculty, staff, and University of Chicago Medicine staff. To ride the shuttle, all passengers should tap a valid UChicago-issued ID or University of Chicago Medicine ID.



CTA BUSES

University students, faculty, and staff, and University of Chicago Medicine staff, ride CTA routes 171 and 172 free upon displaying a valid University-issued ID, University of Chicago Medicine ID, or University of Chicago Laboratory or Charter School ID.

Students in the College must use their CTA Ventra U-Pass card to ride CTA buses and trains. All other riders are required to pay the appropriate CTA fare. Information about all CTA routes can be found at transitchicago.com.

#171 U. OF CHICAGO/HYDE PARK

Serves Lake Shore Drive/54th Street and the 55th-56th-57th St. Metra station. Travels to campus on 55th Street and Ellis Avenue and circles around campus. Operates weekdays from 6:15 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.; Saturdays from 8:00 a.m. to 6:20 p.m. This route operates every 30 minutes middays and Saturdays. After spring convocation, a reduced service schedule goes into effect.

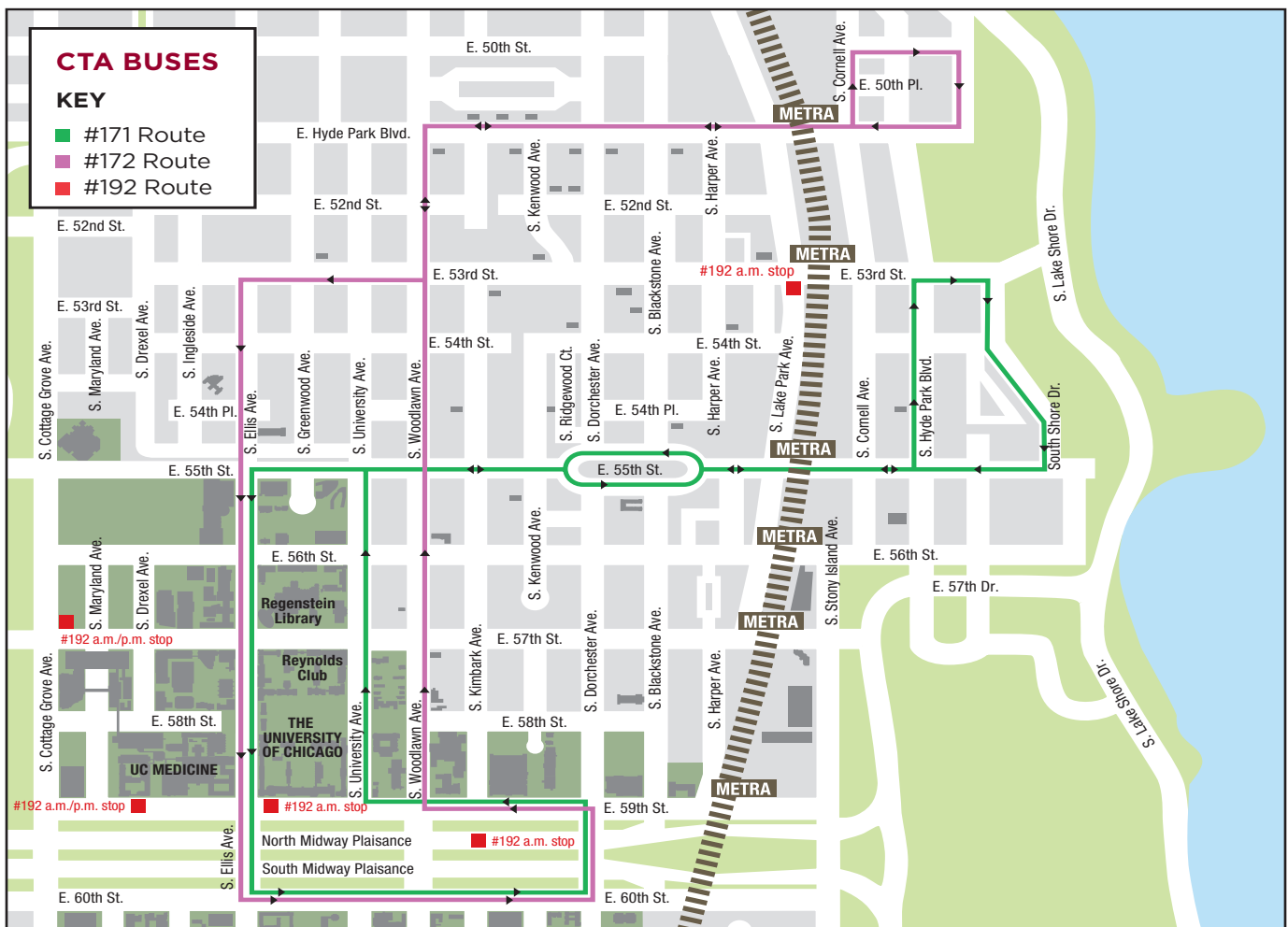
#172 U. OF CHICAGO/KENWOOD

Serves Lake Shore Drive/50th Street and the Hyde Park-53rd Street Metra station. Travels to campus on Hyde Park Boulevard and Ellis Avenue and then circles around campus. Operates weekdays from 6:15 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.; Weekends from 8 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. After spring convocation, a reduced service schedule goes into effect.

#192 U. OF CHICAGO HOSPITALS EXPRESS

(Operates Monday through Friday only)
Southbound service from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m., northbound service from 3:45 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

CTA BUSES NEAR CAMPUS

Several CTA bus routes travel on or very close to campus. They include the #2 Hyde Park Express, #4 Cottage Grove, #6 Jackson Park Express, #10 Museum of Science & Industry, #15 Jeffrey Local, #28 Stony Island, #55 Garfield, #59 59th/61st Street, and #63 63rd Street.

CTA GREEN AND RED LINE TRAINS

The CTA's Green and Red lines run close to campus. When using these rail lines, take the #55 bus route to/from the Garfield stations. Both rail lines travel to the downtown Loop area where it is convenient to transfer to another train or bus. The University's Red Line/Arts Block Route will stop at the Garfield Red Line. The University's South Route shuttle will stop at the Green Line station located at 63rd Street and Cottage Grove Avenue.

University members who sign up for the car sharing program will have their membership fee waived for the first year. The program is open to all students, faculty, and staff ages 18 and older. Applicants must use their uchicago.edu email address to receive the discount, have a valid driver's license, and pay with a credit card.

BIKING

TRANSIT TRACKING

Shuttle movements and arrivals can be tracked online, on a mobile device, or on one of the monitors located in various buildings across campus. The University's transit tracking program also displays any announcements and alerts that may affect the shuttles' movements. The TransLoc app is available through iTunes and the Google Play store.

Benefits-eligible employees can pay for their commuting expenses through a pre-tax parking benefit offered by the University. Transportation expenses can also be covered based on how you commute to work.

EMOTIONAL SUPPORT ANIMALS (ESA) OR ASSISTANCE ANIMALS

Emotional Support Animals (ESA) or Assistance Animals are allowed on the shuttle bus only if they are inside a pet carrier which sits on the passenger's lap or on the floor at their feet. Animals must remain in the carrier at all times while on the bus. Service animals, as defined by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA), are exempt from these requirements.

A student who requires transportation due to temporary or long-term disability should visit transportation.uchicago.edu to fill out the Dial-A-Ride Transportation Request Form. If you have any questions, please contact Transportation & Parking Services between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday (except holidays). Service should be requested at least 24 hours in advance of when service is needed. In the interim, students should arrange other transportation options. Transportation will be provided on campus for classes, meals, appointments, and other University-related activities between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m., Monday through Friday. Pick-up and drop-off times may vary depending on service demands. Injured student transportation will be provided for injured students but not for a third party. Additionally, all campus shuttle and bus transportation are ADA accessible.
