

University of Chicago Police Department (UCPD)
Patrol Area Quarterly Crime Analysis
Year End Statistics for 2023 (Jan – Dec)

The UCPD collects and tracks index crime categories* for its extended patrol area which includes the Kenwood, Hyde Park and Oakland neighborhoods as well as portions of the Woodlawn community. The UCPD shares this information with the Chicago Police Department's 2nd and 3rd Districts to better inform collaborative patrol strategies in efforts to address emerging issues. Below are several key 2023 observations based on the final year end statistics for each of the three distinct community areas that UCPD serves:

North Kenwood / Oakland (NKO)

- NKO reported increases in both overall violent crime and property crime when comparing the number of reported incidents in 2023 to the number of reported incidents in 2022.
- The number of total crimes (violent and property crimes combined) reported for NKO in 2023 is higher than the 5 and 10-year averages for reported total crime.

Hyde Park / South Kenwood (HPSK)

- HPSK reported increases in both overall violent crime and property crime when comparing the number of reported incidents in 2023 to the number of reported incidents in 2022.
- The number of total crimes (violent and property crimes combined) reported for HPSK in 2023 is higher than the 5 and 10-year averages for reported total crime.

Woodlawn (UCPD Area)

- The UCPD patrol area of Woodlawn reported a decrease in overall violent crime and increase in overall property crime when comparing the number of reported incidents in 2023 to the number of reported incidents in 2022.
- The number of total crimes (violent and property crimes combined) reported for the UCPD patrol area of Woodlawn in 2023 is higher than the 5 and 10-year averages for reported total crime.
